## **APPROVAL OF HEALTH INSURANCE**

On January 19, 2017, John Stroud, representing the Union County Agent Cooperative, submitted before the Board of Supervisors two (2) options for providing health insurance with Blue Cross/Blue Shield of Mississippi as primary and Gulf Guaranty Employee Benefit Services, Inc. as GAP.

On February 21, 2017, Morgan-White Insurance Co., submitted before the Board of Supervisors two (2) options providing health insurance with Blue Cross/Blue Shield of Mississippi as primary and AmFirst as GAP.

For both Union County Agent Cooperative and Morgan-White Insurance Co., using Blue Cross/Blue Shield of Mississippi as primary insurance will provide an 80/20 policy with the same benefits. The costs for both companies are the same, \$563.21 per employee.

For GAP, Gulf Guaranty Employee Benefit Services, Inc. with Union County Agent Cooperative, the cost will be \$78.29 per employee plus a \$15.00 commission fee per employee, for a total of \$93.29. For GAP, AmFirst with Morgan-White Insurance Co., the cost will be \$127.68 per employee.

Therefore, the total costs for major medical rates and GAP with Union County Agent Cooperative will be \$656.50 per employee. The total costs for major medical rates and GAP with Morgan-White Insurance Co. will be \$690.89 per employee.

After a review and discussion of all insurances submitted, primary and GAP, a motion was made by Supervisor Chad Coffey and seconded by Supervisor Evan Denton to approve using Option 2 provided by Blue Cross/Blue Shield insurance and Option 1 from Gulf Guaranty as a GAP. With the approval of GAP with Gulf Guaranty, approval of a manual check will be issued to Gulf Guaranty for \$8,220.45.

The vote on the motion was as follows:

After the vote, President David Kitchens declared the motion carried, this the  $22^{nd}$  day of February, 2017.

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
